Single stream and co-educational, Frensham Junior School has a highly experienced team of staff and is set on a magnificent campus of 10 acres with outstanding specialist facilities for core and extra-curricular teaching and learning.

At Frensham Junior School Preschool, we believe that children are capable of constructing their own learning and form an understanding of themselves and their place in the world through their interactions with others. We believe children are effective communicators and that adults act as mentors and guides – promoting, documenting, sharing and reflecting on children’s thinking. Our Preschool children take part in active, outdoor learning, caring for our Land for Wildlife Area, within a native bushland setting. The Preschool playground has been designed to encourage imaginative and constructive play.

Our Preschool is accredited and registered with the Early Childhood Education and Care Directorate and the Australian Children’s Education & Care Quality Authority. Programming is underpinned by the Early Years Learning Framework and Reggio Emilia Philosophy of early

childhood education. Preschool children also participate in an expanded specialist programme, which includes Library, Music and Physical Education sessions. They take part in an annual P-6 Junior Musical and other whole School events.
